



Checking the programme schedule, take the opportunity to match up with a fellow attendee with your shared interests, in a short (three-minute) video networking call.

This is the on-demand section.

- You can navigate around the platform and enter any of the activities happening in the moment from the lobby, or alternatively from the main menu, located on the left-hand side of your screen.
- All programmed sessions that are delivered during the two days of the conference will be available on demand – just use the Replay button.
- There is a Helpdesk in the Exhibition / Poster area of the platform in case you have any problems during the event. Please visit it and a member of staff will be able to assist you.

#### 1—MAKE THE MOST OF THE NETWORKING AREA



This section will help you to match with other BBELT attendees from around the world. Video calls last three minutes in duration, before giving you the option to move on to the next call.

You can exchange contact information by clicking the "Connect" button. You will find your contacts in the 'Connections' page of your profile.

While you can't extend the call time, if you'd like to continue the conversation, you can connect with or find the contact to send them a request for another video call.

However, if you would prefer to find a space where you can meet more people and initiate a group conversation, go to the Concurrent Sessions section where you will find Networking Rooms. Here you have the opportunity to switch on your camera and join a group conversation or interact via the chat box.

Note: In case you haven't already, **create your profile** on the virtual venue.

#### 2—INVITE TO VIDEO, CALL, OR SEND A MESSAGE

Catch up with colleagues and friends. You can invite them to a one-to-one video call.


In the right-hand panel above the chat, you will see a 'People' tab. Click on this to find the names of all attendees. Click on an attendee's name to send a direct message to them via the chat function.

Or you can click 'Invite to video call' to send a request for a video call, which will begin once they accept.

If someone has invited you to a video call or sent you a message, you'll be notified in the 'Messages' tab, and by a red dot appearing beside the envelope icon, which can be found in the top right-hand corner of the page beside your profile avatar.

Click on the envelope icon, then click on the message with the invite to video call, where you'll find a link to a







private video session room. If the other attendee isn't in the call when you join, you can use the direct messaging facility to let them know you're ready, or to co-ordinate a time to meet.
