

Call for Participants to attend Three Day Workshop

Improving Assessment of Air Pollution in Mexican and UK cities

Dates: 6th November- 8th November 2017

Location: Mexico City, Mexico

Under the Researcher Links scheme offered within the Newton Fund, the British Council and The Mexican National Council for Science and Technology (Consejo Nacional de Ciencia y Tecnología, CONACYT) are holding a three-day workshop to bring together researchers to discuss methods to improve assessment of air pollution in Mexican and UK cities. The workshop is being coordinated by Centro Mario Molina, and the Stockholm Environment Institute at the University of York, and will have contributions from other leading Mexican and UK researchers. We are now inviting Early Career Researchers from the UK and Mexico to apply to attend this workshop. The shortlisting of the participants will be done as per the guidelines given in the attached application form. All travel and accommodation expenses for the shortlisted participants will be subsidized/partially reimbursed by the Newton Researcher Links programme. The application form is attached.
